



DISQUALIFICATION DECISIONS FOLLOWING ANTI-DOPING RULES VIOLATION (ADRV) AT THE 13TH AFRICAN GAMES, ACCRA 2023.

The African Union has concluded the result management from the results of the Anti-Doping tests conducted during the 13th African Games.

In line with Article 13.3 of the African Union Anti-Doping rules for the 2023 African Games for Public Disclosure; Two (2) ADRV were managed as follows:

1. OMOLE DOLAPO / MALE / 57KG BOXING / NIGERIA

The urine samples collected during the Event period on the 14th and 20th March, 2024 from Omole Dolapo both returned Adverse Atypical Findings (ATF) for FUROSEMIDE.

Following the case analysis, the AUC result management is satisfied that the athlete has committed an ADRV pursuant to article 2.1 and 2.2 of the AUC Anti-Doping Rule (ADR).

Consequently, in line with article 10.1 of the ADR, his result i.e. GOLD medal has been disqualified, medal withdrawn and deducted from the games medal table.

In accordance with article 7.1.1 of the AUC ADR, the case has been submitted to the International Boxing Association for the finalisation of results management.

2. MORISHOLOMBE DANIEL / MALE / INDOOR HANDBALL / DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

The urine sample collected in- competitions on 15th and 22nd March 2024 from MORISHOLOMBE DANIEL both returned Adverse Analytical Findings (AAF) for CANNABINOIDS/CARBOXY-THC.

Following the case analysis, the AUC result management is satisfied that the athlete has committed an ADRV pursuant to article 2.1 and 2.2 of the AUC Anti-Doping Rule (ADR).

Consequently, in line with article 10.1 of the ADR, his individual result i.e. SILVER medal has been disqualified and the medal withdrawn from him.

In accordance with article 7.1.1 of the AUC ADR, the case has been submitted to the International Handball Federation for the finalisation of results management.
